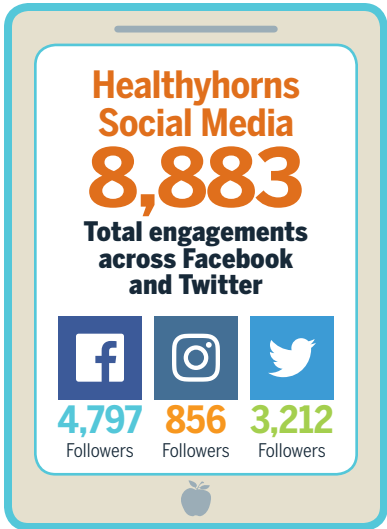
10,993 Flu Shots Administered in the UHS Flu Shot Campaign
